In 2004, we effectively doubled the size and capacity of the emergency department/trauma center at CMC. With more than 50% of admissions to CMC coming through the ED, this expansion renovation was essential to current and future hospital operations. Another key factor in the major modification to this facility was the need to strategically address and reduce the on-going issues of both patient waiting time and the diversion of patients to other facilities.

Designed to accommodate a seven story vertical expansion in the future, the new addition provides separate

entrances—one for ambulatory patients and visitors and one for ambulance and trauma arrivals. Triage has full wireless communication, digital patient tracking and paperless imaging capabilities. There is a dedicated chest pain area as well as a fast track area for more efficient diagnosis and treatment of patients. This new facility is now better able to provide much needed, high quality emergency and trauma care to the residents of the region—efficiently, effectively and always with the safety, security and comfort of the patients and their families in mind.
