McGurrin Hall is the first building that greets you when entering the campus from the highway. Looking at this solidly built four-story building, one would never suspect that the design is as economical as it is functional and beautiful.

The building is the new home for the Panuska College of Professional Studies. All floors are similar in that they contain a variety of classrooms, labs, large group spaces, faculty offices, a waiting/reception area and storage. Because each of the four floors houses a different discipline within the college, all

contain customized features specific to each profession. Some of the unique features included within the building are an advising center, dean's suite, library/brochure area, high tech/distance learning classroom, reading lab, media and technology classroom, science teaching methods lab, demonstration classroom, audio visual room, computer classroom with interactive video, test area, ten-bed and two-bed nursing labs and medication room.
